INTRODUCTION: The PALS Provider Course is an intensive, two day program that utilizes a series of skill development and evaluation stations designed to reinforce and focus the preexisting knowledge of the participants on the skills and teamwork essential for the effective management of cardiac emergencies.

PARTICIPANTS: This course is open to physicians, registered nurses and paramedics. Other health care professionals must first contact the training center for information and registration approval.

PREREQUISITES: As this is not a basic critical care course. Applicants should have a general knowledge of cardiovascular pharmacology, airway management, CPR and electrocardiology and rhythm interpretation.

STATEMENT ON PALS: Pediatric Advanced Life Support Provider programs reinforce the guidelines of care for children experiencing the first ten minutes of a cardiac arrest or near cardiac arrest situation. Small group sessions help to introduce new material and reinforce concepts previously learned.

LOCATION: The location of classes will be the Nursing Education Center at Underwood-Memorial Hospital.
